

Please review the following to ensure that you have everything that you need in order to be fully prepared for a remote assessment with AASHTO re:source.

EQUIPMENT AND TECHNOLOGICAL RESOURCES

- Reliable Wi-Fi throughout entire facility, including all areas where laboratory testing is performed.
 - Ability to download [ZOOM software](#) prior to on-site audits on all computers, tablets, and phones being utilized during the virtual assessment. You may be asked to use multiple devices at once during the assessment in order to provide the assessor with all proper camera angles and views necessary to observe test procedures.
 - A scanner or photo digitizing capabilities for capturing images of your documents and records **OR** documents available in a digital format.
 - Laptops, smartphones, or other mobile devices with high-quality cameras to use during the remote assessment.
 - Capability to do “dry-run” with the Laboratory Assessor(s) prior to the date of the remote assessment to confirm all equipment works properly.
